Stewardship – Local Government

- Increase collaboration and coordination between partners
- 2. Facilitate neighbourhood conservation planning to identify conservation targets and high priority actions
- 3. Promote a coordinated approach to landowner outreach for conservation
- 4. Support **local governments** to incorporate and apply conservation principles into Local Land Use Planning




